

# Payment

Please pay the accommodation tax to the accommodation provider with the method used to pay for your accommodation.

(the accommodation tax collected will be declared and remitted by the accommodation provider to Okinawa Prefecture or to a municipality that has introduced an accommodation tax).

Example: In the case of a simple room stay (one person for one night) at ¥8,500

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{¥8,000} \times 2\% \\ & \text{(the amount is rounded down to the nearest ¥1,000)} \\ & = \text{¥160 accommodation tax} \end{aligned}$$

\*In cases where municipalities charge city accommodation tax, it will be applied as below:

Prefectural accommodation tax: 0.8% (with a maximum amount of ¥800)

Municipality accommodation tax: 1.2% (with a maximum amount of ¥1,200)

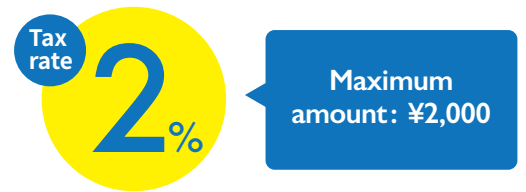

## Preserving Okinawa's scenic beauty and natural environment



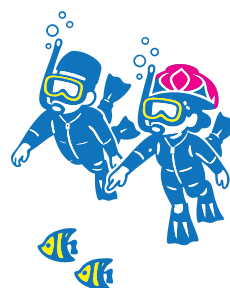
- Improving the cleanliness and appearance of roads in tourist areas
